Using the Environmental Defense Paper Calculator (available online at <http://www.papercalculator.org>), Safeplay Systems was able to estimate the environmental impact of an online catalog versus a traditional paper catalog. The online catalog saves five tons of paper (equivalent to 37 fully grown trees) and 79 million BTU’s of energy. Additional estimated savings are listed on Page 4 of the online catalog.

The new online catalog builds upon a history of doing things “right” at Safeplay Systems.

A PVC-FREE PRODUCT

California has passed a law banning PVC from products intended for use by young children. The EU has had a similar law in place for the past 3 years. Safeplay Systems’ playground structures have been PVC-FREE for 19 years – never had it, never will.

A “GREEN” PRODUCT

EcoPlay® Playgrounds from Safeplay Systems have been made from post-consumer recycled HDPE plastic (milk jugs) for 14 years – long before being “green” became a popular “trend”.

Additionally, Safeplay Systems recycles all of the internally generated off-fall and scrap associated with the normal course of manufacturing production.

Safeplay Systems' environmental commitment extends to the recycling of as many materials as possible from all parts of their business: from packaging, to the oil from trucks, to the magazines and trade journals in the office.

A SUSTAINABLE PRODUCT

EcoPlay[®] Playgrounds from Safeplay Systems are not only made from recycled materials, they can be returned to the manufacturer to be re-recycled into new playground equipment – and Safeplay Systems rewards this re-recycling effort by providing a credit toward a new EcoPlay[®] Playground in exchange for the materials returned.

Safeplay Systems, based in Marietta, Georgia, initially manufactured and sold wooden equipment. Working with one of the top polymer chemists in the country, Safeplay Systems introduced EcoPlay[®] -- one of the strongest materials available. EcoPlay[®] is impermeable to water, cannot be eaten by insects, never needs painting or sealing, and it won't splinter, crack, rust, swell or degrade in any way.

EcoPlay[®] Playgrounds from Safeplay Systems meet and exceed industry standards set by CPSC (Consumer Product Safety Commission), ASTM (American Standards for Testing and Materials), and ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act). Safeplay Systems products are certified by IPEMA (International Playground Equipment Manufacturers Association). In addition, all installations are conducted by a Certified Playground Safety Inspector (CPSI) to assure compliance with all safety codes.
